pril Fools' Day has no real place in Christianity. However,


Abecause it falls on the same day as Easter this year, it sets the perfect stage for Jesus' resurrection. In the best sense, April Fools' Day is about laughter and practical jokes. Many Christians overlook the fact that the Bible it is full of humor. Think of laughable moments like when Elijah suggested that the God Baal might be on the toilet, or when Balaam talks to his ass, or when God made 90 year old Sarah laugh by giving her a baby boy. Even the greatest moment in scripture leaves us laughing. Jesus' resurrection is the clearest sign that God always gets the last laugh. What more could Jesus have done to mock sin, death, and the devil than to rise from the dead? When we say we are Easter people, we say

we believe in God's ultimate victory over all that is opposed to God. We say we are part of God's turning of events to generate bursts of joy as in Psalm 126:2, "Then our mouth was filled with laughter, and our tongue with shouts of joy; then it was said among the nations, "The LORD has done great things for them."

AMAZED BY GOD'S GOODNESS

Easter is full of awesome stories. In one, Mary comes to the empty tomb, crying because Jesus is gone, and then He (well, she thinks He is the gardener) calls out her name, and she knows Jesus as the resurrected Lord. In another, later in the afternoon, Jesus starts walking with two disciples who are headed to their home in Emmaus, and they don't know who He really is until He breaks the bread in their home. Later that night Jesus enters the locked room and forgives the disciples (who all ran away and hid while He was being crucified).

These disciples, plus many others, saw Jesus for the 40 days after his Resurrection, eating with Him, talking to Him, receiving grace and forgiveness. How awesome for them, to be with the One they love, to see (and touch) His resurrected body, to know firsthand that death no longer has the same power. Many of these disciples then went on to preach this good news in such a way that they gave their life for Jesus. Nothing was more important.

Nothing is more important! Jesus is risen! Even though we still experience suffering, death, brokenness, disease, and world problems, in Jesus there is hope. In Jesus God will bring all the good together, and will take all the evil and problematic "junk" and wrap it in loving arms. In Jesus is my hope and life, now and forever. In Jesus, all the truth of the universe is centered.

Wow, the promise of death now destroyed! I am amaZed by God's goodness!

So, what does this mean? I invite you to take a moment and assess your days. How do you experience the presence of Jesus in your life? How does His life make a difference in your brokenness and pain?

I invite you into a spiritual discipline of gratitude: each time you see something of beauty, pray, "Thank you, Jesus." Every time you hear the clock chime at the top of the hour, pray, "Thank you, Jesus." Every time you see the delight of a child, or the wisdom of the aged, pray, "Thank you, Jesus." Every time you think about it, give thanks. This small prayer is just one way to open your heart to what the Resurrection Jesus is doing in your life.

I pray that you continue to grow in Jesus, as His love surrounds you with grace, into forever!


SUNDAY, APRIL 8TH 12:00 PM

Hundreds of people walk by it each week. The miniature church replica at the top of the ramp into the sanctuary was hand crafted by Fred Kazmaier in 1990. Fred carved every piece, except the exterior from a wood beam taken from the original 1917 church building. Made in exquisite detail, Fred handcrafted the interior, the wood plank flooring, pews, organ and altar. The altar cloths are handstitched. Even the potbellied stove was formed from the metal of tomato paste cans.
