STAINED GLASS WINDOW UPDATE

Bigelow Windows has completed work on 20 windows and have 2 more in process. These are in the upper stairwell by the back of the sanctuary. After those come back, we will only have 6 more to go! The last 6 will be :The Baptism of Jesus/Lord's Supper; a decorative window in the stairwell; Lord, Save Me; Revelation/Behold, I Stand at the Door and Knock; Mary Sitting at Jesus' Feet; and the Holy Family/Birth of Christ. As of October 14, 2025, our fund balance is **\$73,265.11**. Once we are invoiced for the cry room/bathroom windows (\$12,760), we will need to spend another \$64,295 to finish the remaining windows. That means we need \$3,789.89 to complete all the window restoration. Woo Hoo! Words cannot describe how appreciative we are for the generosity shown by this congregation in their donations and attendance at events which highlighted the windows!
